BS: Continuity for next year? TB, MG, and AY are the only returnees for next year. SB running for another term.

 Asks TB, AY, and MG to serve on grad funding subcommittee for next year on order to maintain some continuity.

BS: Group of CLAS faculty are working on coordinating hosting of Ukrainian scholars. FC can/should support that effort as possible.

DR: BoT is meeting this month with every college dean; each dean makes a $^{\sim}15$ min presentation to educate board members about issues critical for their colleges and for university more generally, particularly with issues of resources/support for colleges. DR plans to make 3 points to BoT:

- BoT wants to know about academic reputation/rankings/metrics, etc. Across AAU
 nationwide, almost all CLAS units are in middle two quartiles with highest quartile
 largely dominated by immensely well-funded private institutions.
- Staff recruitment/retention/financing; need to be more competitive. Need for an 'academy' to staff university w/o having various units of university competing against one another.
- Graduate funding
- Faculty career progress depends on research feasibility and that often involves remote sites: archives, field sites such as archaeological, marine, etc. We need more resources for that.

SH: Need for training of competent/motivated Gainesville locals in research admin skills.

BS: Possibility of partnering with Santa Fe College?
