1 CALL TO ORDER & CHAIR'S WELCOME:

Dr. Melissa Mellon, Chair of the Faculty Assembly, called the meeting to order at 3:03, introduced herself and welcomed everyone to the Fall Assembly. Approximately forty-seven (47) people were present.

2 Approval of the Minutes from The Spring 2023 Assembly

The minutes were approved unanimously via voice vote.

3 Address to the Faculty, Dr. David Richardson, Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences

Dean Richardson gave a warm welcome to the faculty. His address focused on transitions, education, and research.

Dean Richardson noted that the university was in a period of transition with respect to the new administration and new state laws, creating uncertainty. It's the intention of the university to navigate this transition and remain a top research and instructional university.

He noted the importance of expanding experiential research for undergraduates. The university expects to invest in expanding initiatives beyond current opportunities. He also discussed protecting graduate education as well as finding ways to maintain and meet our obligations to graduate students, including those on assistantships.

Dean Richardson noted the initiatives from the president's office intended to increase the research profile of the university.
